2. To approve minutes of meeting of Academic Council held on 10/04/2024.
 - 2.1 To approve of examination reforms under NEP2020 from AY 2024-25 as approved by AC in its meeting held on 10/04/2024.
 - 2.1.1 Promotion of the learners' w.e.f. AY 2024-25: Learners must obtain minimum 12 credits in each semester for total 24 credits (Cumulative of Sem I & II) at the end of each academic year to make them eligible to secure admission in the next year. The Academic Council decided to keep this point open for deliberation till the next Academic Council meeting.
 - 2.1.2 Rules for passing of Co-Curricular Courses: Learners who have failed / not completed CC (either in Sem I and / II) will be allotted National Service Scheme under CC.
 - 2.1.3 Result declaration: For the examinations held in the First Half of 2024, all the results to be declared in the first week of May
 - 2.1.4 Question paper review will be implemented from Sem II of AY 2023-24.
 - 2.1.5 Examination on Demand for the B.Sc. Data Science and BCA programs: The Academic Council suggested that the on demand exam should be held prior to the college scheduled exam.
 - 2.1.6 Open Book examinations: The Academic Council suggested that rigorous training for teachers in the preparation of question papers for Open Book Examinations
 - 2.1.7 Non-NEP and NEP equivalence: For facilitating the lateral movement of learners from Non-NEP frameworks to NEP frameworks for programs under the DSC and SSC models, learners, including dropouts and those from other Higher Education Institutions will be required to undertake bridge courses related to major mandatory courses of the respective program. Learners transferring from other HEIs, in order to graduate, must accumulate the same number of credits as approved by the Academic Council for the program they enroll in.
 - 2.2 To approve syllabi recommended for SY UG – Semesters III and IV in alignment with NEP structure to be implemented from the AY 2024-2025 and as approved by AC in its meeting held on 10/04/2024.
 - 2.3 To approve syllabi recommended for PG Part II Programs – Semesters III and IV in alignment with NEP structure to be implemented from the AY 2024-2025 and as approved by AC in its meeting held on 10/04/2024.
 - 2.4 To approve revisions in the syllabi recommended for FYUG Courses in Semesters I & II to be implemented from the AY 2024-2025 and as approved by AC in its meeting held on 10/04/2024.
