The activities and achievements of Research Promotion and Assessment Committee are given below –

I. Minor Research Projects

Minor Research Projects were approved at institutional level for both students and faculty. 10 Research Projects by students and 01 Research Project by the faculty of the institute were sanctioned as per the research policy and provided with the research grant.

II. Research Papers

Numerous research papers by faculties were presented and published in various national, international, UGC Care, ABDC listed and SCOPUS journals. Students of the institute participated in National, International Research Conferences and Competitions. 05 research papers were presented and selected for publication in National International Peer Reviewed Journals.

Faculties and Students participated in the Institutional Research Conclave conducted by PTVA's Institute of Management on 05th March 2025. Two research papers were awarded with Best Research Paper recognition

- ii) Mr. Priyanshu Gupta (MSc. Finance) received Best Researcher Award in Student Category

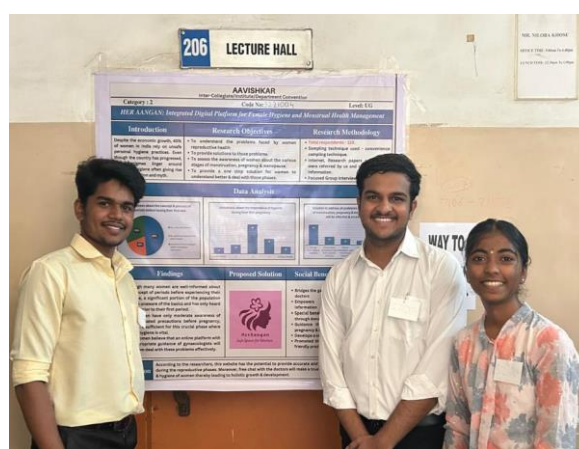
III. Aavishkar Research Convention 2024 – 25
